²¹ Then they dug another well, but they quarreled over that one also; so he named it Sitnah. (Opposition)

Genesis 26:22

22 He moved on from there and dug another well, and no one quarreled over it. He named it Rehoboth, (Open Spaces) saying, "Now the LORD has given us room and we will flourish in the land."

**Rehoboth: The place of Deliverance, The
place of fruitfulness.**

**Esek and Sitnah: Contention and hatred,
place of strife, struggle, heavy labor,
arguments, dissention, and competition,
and anger.**

Genesis 26:23-24

²³ Then he went up from there to Beersheba. ²⁴ And the LORD appeared to him the same night and said, “*I am* the God of your father Abraham; do not fear, for *I am* with you. I will bless you and multiply your descendants for My servant Abraham’s sake.”
